This website will consist of 5 pages which will be linked together. Each page will have it's own focus and design; Navigation should be consistently placed to maintain continuity.

Page 1: (index.html) Concept: you: as you really are.

Imagery: photo. Photo Size: 760 x 420 (page may be larger).

Photo may be manipulated, but should portray who you are. .

Written content: introductory paragraph introducing yourself to the class.

Layout use tables, Design mode in DW

Page 2: Concept: you as a superhero. Imagery: Vector. Imagery 760 x 420 (page

may be larger). Imagery and page should reflect your special and unique superpowers.

Written content: tell us your superhero bio.

Layout: tables and/or CSS

Page 3: Concept: retrospective: as you celebrate your 130th birthday,

you've been asked to reflect back on your glorious accomplishment. Imagery and written content should show some of your amazing story.

(760 x 4320- vector or photo imagery)

Layout CSS

Page 4: Your social self. Should link to a social networking site WHICH WE

CAN VIEW. Content should be appropriate to the class and should be maintained throughout the semester. (Upkeep is part of your class grade).

Some ideas: Facebook, Verb, Beautifulsociety, Twitter, Humblevoice, etc. **NOT MYSPACE.**

Page 5: Projects and links.
