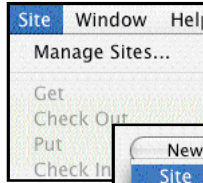
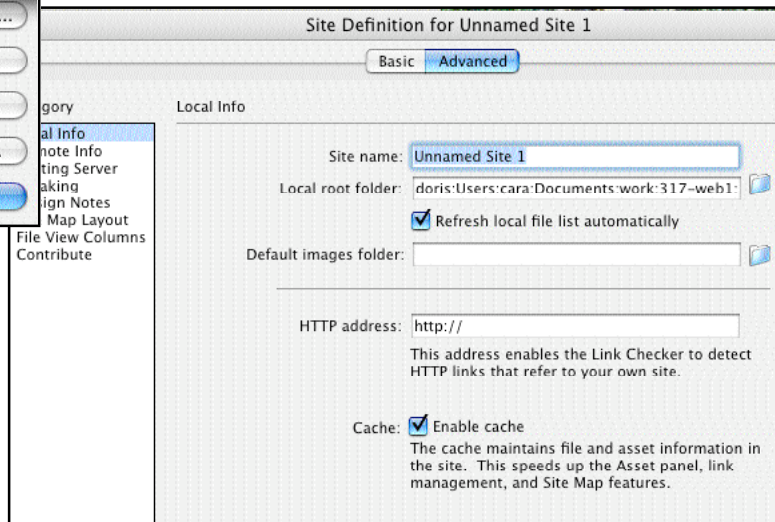


# Introduction to the Dreamweaver MX 2004 Interface

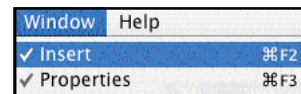
## Site management



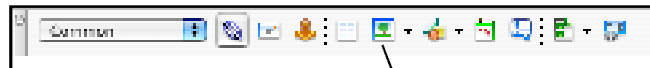
After setting up the folder for your site, you must open Dreamweaver and tell it where you will be storing all folders and files for your site. This is done in the site management panel. Choose- new- site . Name this something so that you can recognize it in a list of sites by other students. Then navigate to the main folder for your site (not archives) that you have already placed on your hard drive.



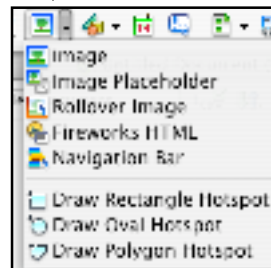
Always keep both the INSERT and PROPERTIES panels open.



### Insert Common



This is where you go to insert images, rollovers, anchors, tables, links, etc..



### Layout



The layout panel (in the insert panel) allows you to chose layout options and insert frames (among other things.)
